COURSE DESCRIPTION

Dear colleagues,

On behalf of the European Society of Musculoskeletal Radiology (ESSR) Tumour Subcommittee and the Italian Society of Medical and Interventional Radiology (SIRM), we are pleased to invite you to join the ESSR Tumour Course and Pre-Course Workshop, which will be held in Milan, Italy on 29th-31st January 2025.

The Pre-Course Workshop will be held on 29th January 2025. This workshop will be aimed at all young attendees of the Tumour Course (in training or up to 35 years of age, with Tumour Course registration also covering Pre-Course Workshop). The workshop will include basics lectures as well as clinical cases on bone and soft-tissue tumours, followed by interactive discussion with expert radiologists. Clinical cases will be presented by young radiologists or radiologists in training following an open call and selection*. All applicants selected for case presentation will receive free Pre-Course Workshop and Tumour Course registrations.

The Tumour Course will be held on 30th-31st January 2025. This course will be aimed at radiologists and radiologists in training interested in bone and soft-tissue tumours. Lectures will cover diagnostic challenges commonly addressed in everyday life for general radiologists, but also more advanced topics and recent updates on the diagnosis and management of bone and soft-tissue tumours for subspecialised musculoskeletal radiologists. Expert international speakers from different backgrounds will share their knowledge and experience, offering an incredible learning opportunity for all the attendees.
